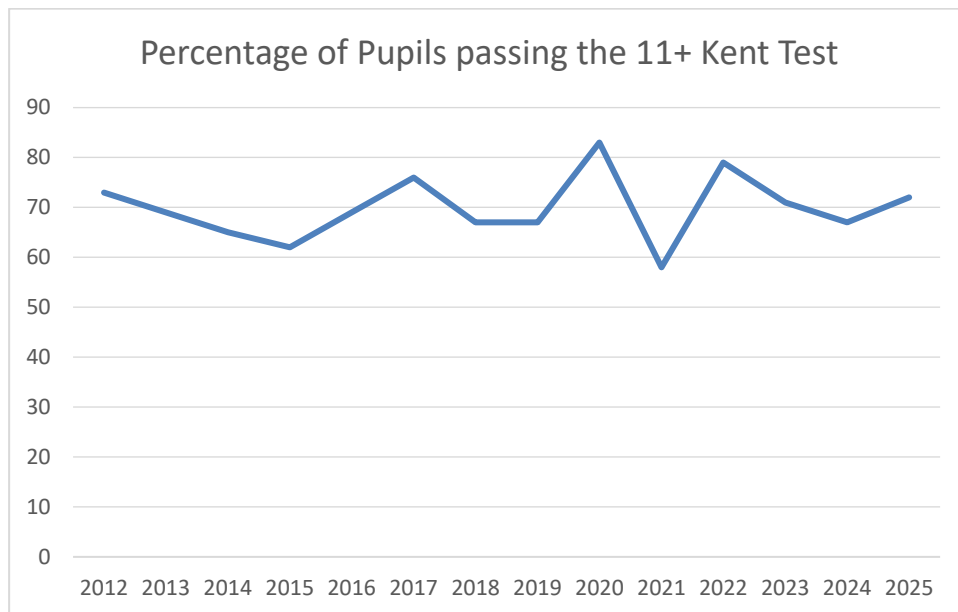

Year 6 Academic Outcomes

We are exceptionally proud of our Year 6 pupils, whose achievements reflect their hard work, determination and the dedication of our staff.

Arithmetic:

- 65% of pupils achieved Greater Depth or Greater Depth Plus (13/20 pupils).
- 90% of pupils (18/20) were working at expected, greater depth or greater depth plus.
- 90% of pupils (18/20) made good or exceptional progress.

Reading:

- 35% of pupils achieved Greater Depth or Greater Depth Plus (7/20 pupils).
- 90% of pupils (18/20) were working at Expected, Greater Depth or Greater Depth Plus.
- 90% of pupils (18/20) made good or exceptional progress.

These outcomes demonstrate the consistently high standards achieved by our pupils and the strong academic foundations they developed during their time at Wellesley Haddon Dene.
